The Sr. Estimator/Designer will be responsible for managing and completing all Estimates and Quotations. The ideal applicant will have extensive knowledge of Process Packaging Equipment and the ability to read P&IDs and client specifications. The applicant will also have extensive knowledge creating package models within Solidworks and export BOMs. This position will work closely with and report to Senior Vice President of Canadian Operations.

1.1 Specific responsibilities

- Take client specifications/P&IDs and create modelling in Solidworks.
- Export all BOMs from Solidworks modelling and gather pricing from 3rd party vendors.
- Work with Operations to set budgeted hrs for projects.
- Create estimated cost summary for projects.
- Create detailed Tenders based on clients specifications and Enercorp specifications.
- Kick off projects to Engineering and Operations based on contractual obligations from clients PO.
- Track and manage scope changes.
- Provide technical assistance during quoting process.
- Work within Engineering team to create design packages and IFP/IFA/IFC drawings for construction for fabrication shop.
- Create P&IDs / models based on client specifications.
- Knowledge of Compress calculations would be an asset however not required.
- Knowledge in structural analysis for mobile skids would be an asset however not required.
- Knowledge of ASME codes B31.3 and Sec VIII Div1 would be an asset however not required.

Software experience: Solidworks and Draftsight is required. ERP System experience of NetSuite or similar would be a bonus.

- CET would be preferred, however is not a requirement based on solidworks/industry experience.
- Minimum of 5-10 years of experience in Solidworks/drafting/Estimating roles.
- Strong knowledge of ASME codes and standards would be an asset.
- Prior experience working with custom manufacturing within the oil and gas industry is required.
